

TAHPERD Vendor Policy

1. A TAHPERD member may present an educational program at a TAHPERD conference at no charge if the member, or member's school, educational institution, or company is not directly benefiting financially from the presentation.

2. If a TAHPERD member is paid by a company or product/services and their presentation promotes the sale of a product and/or services, the member is considered a vendor and must follow the Vendor Guidelines designated below.

A. TAHPERD Annual Convention

A vendor may present an Exhibitor's Showcase Session if they have purchased a booth in the Exhibit Hall and pay an additional \$250 for the session.

B. TAHPERD Summer Conference

1) A vendor may present an Exhibitor's Showcase Session for \$250 if they have purchased a booth in the Exhibit Hall.

2) A vendor who exhibited at the previous TAHPERD Annual Convention may present an Exhibitor's Showcase Session at no charge if they have purchased a booth in the Exhibit Hall.

3. A TAHPERD member working in an exhibitor's booth at the TAHPERD Annual Convention or the Summer Conference must pay the convention/conference registration fee and be a current TAHPERD member.

4. A TAHPERD member hired by a vendor to work in the vendor's exhibit booth may present the vendor's Exhibitor's Showcase Session provided the appropriate fee has been paid. This member may also present an educational session (no fee) as long as there is no logo representation of a vendor or mention of a vendor's product.

The intent of these policies is to insure that all TAHPERD members and vendors are treated fairly. The exposure and marketing of a business and/or vendor at a TAHPERD event provides a money making opportunity and requires the purchase of that opportunity. When a TAHPERD member benefits in such a manner, they are considered a vendor.
