


Criteria 13
Safety Report Check List



1.	Dedicated indoor and outdoor facilities for physical education classes
2.	All indoor and outdoor physical education program, playgrounds, and activity areas shall meet Federal Americans with Disability Act Accessibility Guidelines
3.	Enough separate teaching stations should be available for teachers to be able to conduct classes without interference from other PE classes or other school activities. Teaching spaces shall allow for adequate square footage per student.
4.	Indoor facilities shall have appropriate air control systems to ensure healthy indoor environmental quality
5.	Indoor facilities shall be well lit and equipped with ample electrical power outlets
6.	Federal Title IX guidelines must be met to ensure equitable opportunities for both boys and girls
7.	The flooring of the teaching spaces should be kept clean and dry.
8.	The flooring of the gym/indoor facility should be cleaned on a daily basis and sanitized regularly
9.	Outdoor play areas should have age-specific play areas with appropriate ground cover
Equipment and Teaching Spaces	
10-a	Outdoor play areas and teaching spaces are checked at least once a month for needed repairs
10-b	Outdoor play areas and teaching spaces are checked every day for trash, glass, and other harmful objects
10-c	All equipment (balls, ropes, etc.) are checked daily for needed repairs
10-d	All equipment (balls, ropes, etc.) are kept clean and sanitized regularly
10-e	Indoor play areas and teaching spaces are checked daily for any harmful objects or situations
10-f	Indoor and outdoor play areas and teaching spaces are checked monthly for safety of lighting, electrical sources, leaks, and any other hazardous situations and repairs are made
11.	Inside and outside teaching areas provide students with adequate access to water and shade
12.	Teaching and playing areas close to streets or other hazards shall have physical barriers such as a fence or walls protecting the students
